### **Brief History**

The origin of BCC Lanka Limited (BCCL) goes back to the year 1918, when a group of European Entrepreneurs incorporated a Company named British Ceylon Corporation Ltd. (BCC). Subsequently, the BCC and its subsidiaries namely, British Ceylon Milling Company Ltd, (BCMCL) and Ceylon Extraction Company Ltd. (CECL) were acquired by then government on February 25, 1972 under the Business Undertaking (Acquisition) Act No. 35 of 1971. Later on operations of CECL was ceased in 1976.

The BCCL, the present Company was incorporated on October 21, 1988 under the conversion of Public Corporation and Government Owned Business Undertakings into Public Companies Act No. 23 of 1982, to take over the function of the government owned BCC and its subsidiary BCMCL. This conversion was gazetted on November 4, 1988 and new Company BCCL commenced operations on December 6, 1988.
